## **LBUSD Facilities and Grounds Prepared for Students**

The “Three S’s”, safety, security, and sanitation, define the daily duties of the LBUSD Facilities and Grounds Department. Under the dynamic direction of Eric Jetta, Director, the department has completed many of the projects that were outside the scope of the recent modernization and is progressing toward the finish line for the balance of the remaining repairs, renovation and upgrades which include infrastructure and installation of technological advances used in the classroom.

HVAC has been installed at the El Morro and Top of the World Elementary Multipurpose Rooms and the Laguna Beach High School Administration Office. School site sports fields are in top condition with all of the irrigation district-wide sites repaired, adjusted, and modified. As a part of our District’s ongoing Energy Management Program, EMP, two main irrigation controllers were replaced. This will help manage and monitor field watering while conserving water and keeping our fields in the best condition possible.

The Board of Education has adopted a long term Facilities Repair and Replacement Program and Mr. Jetta is committed to keeping our facilities and grounds in the finest condition for years to come. This continues to be a key focus and challenge for Jetta and his department.
